
Objective #1

Equip participants with meaningful techniques of LEGO SERIOUS PLAY to build youth organisation's strategy to support organisation development and quality youth work.





#2 via Riga Airport


If you are landing in Riga airport you can catch a direct bus from Riga airport to Siauliai. Very convinient. Find the timetable here:

Reimbursement conditions

Buying all tickets is an obligation of participants (with partners' organisations support).

In order to be reimbursed participant has to:

- **provide all evidences of travelling: coach/train tickets,boarding passes, invoices etc. as well as the evidence of payment (e.g.bank transcript of payment).**
- **complete participant's survey which will be sent after the TC comes to an end from official EC platform**
- **organise the multiplier event in own community and prepare a report with evidences (e.g. pictures)**

The reimbursement will be done via bank transfer therefore we would kindly ask participants to have their bank details ready to submit during the training course. (Name and full address of the account holder, Name and full address of the bank,IBAN, SWIFT (BIC))


